

Overall

- By October, 2009, a total of 128 BPS students completed the Credit Recovery Program (CR) and earned a high school diploma.
- 97 CR completers were members of the 2009 Cohort: being a part of the graduating class of 2009, they raised the district's overall 4-year graduation rate by 2 percentage points.
- 18 CR completers were members of the 2008 Cohort and contributed to district's 5-Year graduation rate of 66.4%.
- 4 CR completers were members of the 2007 Cohort.
- 9 CR completers were members of cohorts prior to 2007.
- The 4-Year graduation rates at individual schools were also positively impacted by the CR program: at 25 schools, the number of students who graduated after participating in CR contributed to rate increases ranging from 0.3 points at Madison Park High, to 16.4 points at PATH (see table below).
