





K-8 program models in the Boston Public Schools

Boston Public Schools has adopted several models to provide students and families with educational continuity between the elementary and middle grades through programs that span kindergarten through grade 8 (K-8). Superintendent Carol Johnson’s **Pathways to Excellence** plan would expand the number of K-8 programs from 21 to 29, offering access to K-8 continuity to 6,000 more students.
