Important: New Residency Policy for the Boston Exam Schools

In June 2010, the Boston School Committee revised the residency policy for students seeking admission to the examination schools. The new policy requires that students live in the City of Boston on or before the first Friday in November to apply for exam school admission.

If your child is applying to a Boston exam school for September 2011 and currently attends a private, parochial, METCO, or charter school, you must present residency proofs and photo identification at a Boston Public Schools Family Resource Center beginning October 1st, but no later than November 5, 2010.

T - Z	October 25 – October 29
All	November 1 – November 5

Please be advised that only students who are residents of the City of Boston as of the November deadline will be considered and/or invited for admission to the exam schools.
