Beginning in March 2010, BPS will post customized menus for all 135 schools at www.SchoolMenu.com.

Benefits

The www.SchoolMenu.com site offers more than just menus. The BPS Department of Food & Nutrition Services can use the site to post detailed nutritional information about menu items and share important information about wellness, nutrition, allergies, fitness and other related topics. Students can learn more about nutrition through the games and activities posted in the site's "Kids Area."



Parents can register on the site by creating a user name and password that will allow them to quickly access their child's school menu in the future. Parents whose children attend multiple BPS schools can even add more than one school to their account to easily keep track of their children's meals.

How to register

Go to www.SchoolMenu.com and follow the instructions under "New Member Signup" to register. Once you've registered, sign in with the username and password you created, and it will take you right to your school's menu page.

How to view your school's menu without registering

If you prefer not to register, you may view a school's menu under "Parent Member" by selecting "Quickly View a School's Menu" and then select the state, city and specific school from the drop-down menus.
