The writing sample, or essay, that is part of ISEE is not part of the Boston exam. The four subtests are Verbal Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Quantitative Reasoning, and Mathematics Achievement.

## *Introduction*

---

The School Committee of the City of Boston requires applicants to take the ISEE on Saturday, November 5, 2011 at special test centers for admission to Boston Latin Academy, Boston Latin School, and the John D. O'Bryant School of Mathematics & Science.

Students must officially be in:

- A. Grade 6 for SY 2011-2012 to take the test for grade 7 for SY 2012-2013 for all three exam schools.
  
- B. Grade 8 for SY 2011-2012 to take the test for grade 9 for SY 2012-2013 for all three exam schools.
  
- C. Grade 9 for SY 2011-2012 to take the test for grade 10 for SY 2012-2013 for John D. O'Bryant School of Mathematics and Science only.

## *Registering for the ISEE*

---

Included with this Bulletin is a registration form you will need to complete in order to take the test. When completed, the form must be returned to your Principal/Headmaster on or before September 30, 2011. If the student is currently attending an unlisted school (school code 8888) or is presently home-schooled, please deliver the registration form to Boston Public Schools, Enrollment Planning & Support, 26 Court Street 4th Floor, Boston, MA 02108.

Please print the information requested in each square and fill in the correct bubble below the letter or number. Indicate a space by leaving a blank box. Individuals should not knowingly falsify information and should understand that applications are signed under the pain and penalties of perjury.

**Student Name:** Enter your full, legal name (no nicknames).

**Student's Home Address:** Enter the address of your current home residence at the time of registration.

**Describe Yourself:** Fill in one box only

**Current Grade in School:** This exam is for students in grades 6, 8 or 9 only.

## *Registering for the ISEE (continued)*

**School Now Attending:** The four-digit code for the school you are now attending may be found on pages 14-17 of the Bulletin.

**BPS ID Number:** This box is for current Boston Public Schools students only. Please enter your six-digit student ID number.

**Test Center Names:** Test center codes may be found on page 14 of the Bulletin. Test center locations are not guaranteed and are based on available space.

Your exam admission ticket will be sent by ERB to the Principal/Headmaster of your school and distributed to students during the week of October 31, 2011. For students attending an unlisted school (school code 8888), tickets will be mailed to your home address.

The ticket will show your assigned Test Center location and registration number. Please be advised that Test Center assignments cannot be changed.

## *Exam School Residency Policy*

In June 2010, the Boston School Committee revised the residency policy for students seeking admission to the examination schools. The new policy requires that students live in the City of Boston on or before the first Friday in November to apply for admission.

Boston School Committee policy defines residence as the place where a person/family dwells permanently, not temporarily, and is the place that is the center of his or her domestic, social, and civic life. Temporary residence in the City of Boston solely for the purpose of attending a Boston Public School shall not be considered residency.

The residency policy applies to applicants currently attending private, parochial, METCO, charter schools, home schooling, and schools outside the City of Boston. **Parents of such applicants must bring residency proofs and parent photo identification in person to a Boston Public Schools Family Resource Center beginning October 3rd, but no later than November 4, 2011. Please note that most charter schools are not part of the Boston Public Schools.**

Please be advised that only students who are residents of the City of Boston as of the November 4th deadline will be considered for admission and/or invited to an exam school. Please pay close attention to the requirements and dates noted above as there are no exceptions to the residency policy.

## *Note to Parents/Guardians*

Parents/Guardians or school personnel must report any serious illness/injury, family crisis, or other unusual circumstances that might affect a student's performance **prior to** the test administration on November 5, 2011.

If such a situation arises, please carefully consider whether to send your child to the test center. Please contact Enrollment Planning & Support at 617-635-9512 to discuss any circumstances or events that may affect your child's performance and to determine if a make-up test is needed. If the student attends the test administration despite any circumstances or event that might affect his/her performance, a make-up test will not be an option.

# Making Arrangements for the ISEE

## *Note to Parents/Guardians (continued)*

The make-up test for the ISEE will take place on Saturday, November 19, 2011 at Boston Latin School, 78 Avenue Louis Pasteur, Boston, MA 02115.

The Boston Public Schools will not retest a student under any circumstances after November 19, 2011. No new or additional information will be considered as grounds for retesting after the make-up test date.

## *Testing with Accommodations*

The Boston Public Schools will arrange for students with documented disabilities to take the test with special accommodations. To be eligible, the student must have a disability that require testing with accommodations and have appropriate documentation that establishes a current need.

All requests for special accommodation testing must be submitted by October 7, 2011 to make arrangements for the November 5th exam. Confirmation letters will be mailed home the first week in November detailing approved accommodations. Please be advised that special accommodations will not be granted at the test site without a confirmation letter from Enrollment Planning & Support.

## *Sunday Test Administration*

A special Sunday test administration will be given for students who cannot sit for the Saturday administration due to religious reasons. This special administration will be held on Sunday, November 6, 2011 at Boston Latin School. To register for the Sunday test please contact Maria Vieira at 617-635-9512. Students must complete the ISEE registration form for the November 5th test date in order to receive an admission ticket.

## Alternative Dates and Additional Scores

### *Walk-in Registration*

---

For students who missed the registration deadline, there will be limited opportunity for walk-in registration at the make-up test on November 19, 2011. It is important to understand that walk-in registration is NOT guaranteed due to limits on test materials, space, and staff. The make-up test administration will be held on Saturday, November 19, 2011 at Boston Latin School only. Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis after preregistered candidates have been accommodated. Please note that walk-in registration will not be available on November 5th.

### *Alternative Test Date*

---

Families have the opportunity to register for a national ISEE administration on an alternative date with the Education Records Bureau. However, the Boston Public Schools will only accept one set of test scores. **The deadline to take the ISEE to apply to a Boston exam school is November 19, 2011.** There are no exceptions to this policy.

Students applying to multiple schools including the exam schools may want to consider taking the ISEE at a national test site. A national test administration will allow scores to be sent to the Boston Public Schools and an additional five ERB member schools. The school code for the Boston Exam Schools is 888888. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure that the ISEE scores from a national test administration are forwarded to Enrollment Planning & Support for receipt by Friday, December 16, 2011. ### *Score Report Request*

---

Students taking the ISEE with Boston Public Schools have the option of sending a score report to six additional ERB member schools other than the Boston exam schools. There is a \$95 fee for this service. Please refer to the last page of this Bulletin for the request form.

Your scores will be reported automatically to Boston Public Schools. Parents will be notified of test results in mid-March. The Boston Public Schools do not provide a transcript service. If you are interested in receiving a copy of your child's scores in January 2012, you must request scores to be sent to additional schools as well.

# Getting Ready for the ISEE

## *The ISEE*

---

**The Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE)** consists of four subtests and is administered for the City of Boston by the Educational Records Bureau. The Middle Level test will be used for candidates entering Grade 7. The Upper Level test will be used for candidates entering Grades 9 and 10. The examination consists of verbal and quantitative reasoning sections that measure your capability for learning. It also consists of reading comprehension and mathematics achievement sections that provide specific information about what you have learned in school in these subject areas. The Boston Public Schools test administration does not include an essay component.

### **ISEE MIDDLE and UPPER LEVELS**

#### **Verbal Reasoning** (Both Levels)

- synonyms
- sentence completion

#### **Quantitative Reasoning** (Middle Level)

- concepts/understanding
- applications/higher order thinking
- quantitative comparison

#### **Quantitative Reasoning** (Upper Level)

- arithmetic/algebra/geometry
- concepts/understanding
- applications/higher order thinking
- quantitative comparison

#### **Reading Comprehension** (Both Levels)

- humanities passages
- science passages
- social studies passages

#### **Mathematics Achievement** (Middle Level)

- knowledge and skills
- computation/comprehension
- applications

#### **Mathematics Achievement** (Upper Level)

- arithmetic/algebra/geometry
- knowledge and skills
- comprehension
- applications

The entire test takes about two hours and ten minutes. The time will vary somewhat depending on such factors as the length of time required to read directions, answer questions, etc.

# Getting Ready for the ISEE

## *Test Preparation*

---

The Educational Records Bureau (ERB) understands the value and desire for parents and students to “see” the types of questions that will be presented on each level of the test, and help make it as fair as possible for all families to gain access to the same information preparing students for the test. ERB is pleased to offer a preparation book for each level FREE of charge when downloaded from the website [www.iseetest.org](http://www.iseetest.org). Preparation books may also be purchased in a hard copy format for \$20 each\*.

Each book includes level-specific background information about the ISEE test and experience, sample questions, a full-length practice test, scoring information. Please understand that these books are not training books for exam strategies, and they are not a shortcut to higher scores. The goal of these books is to help families understand the format of the test being taking, the directions given, the types of test items, and the answer sheet used.

While other companies claim to have ISEE preparation books, know that these books are the only books authorized and approved by ERB.

\* Please note that if you choose to order the preparation book the cost of \$20 includes shipping and handling in the United States. The book is sent through the U.S. Postal Service using Priority Mail. Please allow 5-7 business days for delivery upon receipt of your order. If you live outside the United States, please call 1-800-446-0320 or (919) 956-8524 for the international shipping cost and delivery time. # Getting Ready for the ISEE

## Getting Ready for the ISEE

- The best way to prepare for the ISEE is to continue to work hard at your studies.
- You should attempt to answer every question, but do not spend too much time on any one question. It is better to go on to the next question. You may return to omitted questions if time permits.
- You will not be penalized on the test for guessing, but avoid making wild guesses. If you can eliminate one or more incorrect answers, you increase your chances of being right.
- Do not worry if you are unable to complete the test. No student is expected to answer every question correctly.
- In general, ISEE scores show what you have gradually learned over a period of time. Last minute cramming for the test is not helpful.

## Test Day Schedule and Procedures

The test site supervisor will assign you to a testing room where test materials will be distributed after you have completed a Supplementary Application Form.

- a. Since pencils are NOT supplied at the Test Center, you must bring several sharpened No. 2 pencils and a clean eraser with you.
- b. The test administrator will give you all the instructions you will need to take the test.
- c. Books, magazines, calculators and calculator watches, timers, stop watches, etc., will not be allowed in the test room.
- d. The test supervisor will not allow any visitors into the test rooms. Parents will not be allowed to enter or remain at the test site.
- e. Test administrators will invalidate the test and dismiss any student who violates the expected rules of conduct including, but not limited to:
  - giving or receiving help
  - causing undue disturbance
  - using notes, calculators, or other aids
  - failing to follow instructions
  - purposely working on the wrong section of the test
  - attempting to take the test for someone else
  - using cell phones, pagers, or beepers.

## Getting Ready for the ISEE

- f. At the end of the test, the test administrator will collect all test materials. Candidates will not be allowed to remove any test materials from the test room.
- g. Walk-in students may not be tested without proper identification.

In the event of a dispute concerning a candidate's behavior during the test, ERB will allow the candidate to provide additional information to resolve the matter if possible. ERB reserves the right, however, to cancel a candidate's test scores if there is reason to question their validity.

NOTE: The ISEE is a secure test.
