## Student Identification for the ISEE

All students registered for the ISEE test administration on Saturday, November 5, 2011 are required to provide positive identification at the test center. Examples of acceptable student identification include a passport, green card, or School ID. **Student Identification Letters may also be written by the Principal/Headmaster or school staff member on school letterhead.** (*Student identification letters may not be written by a parent/guardian.*)

Schools may use the attached Student Identification Letter template and copy onto official school letterhead or provide a school seal/ stamp.

Students will not be admitted to the test center without proper identification under any circumstances. Principals/Headmasters should assist all students without photo identification to obtain a Student Identification Letter.
