## *Language Arts*

Our class is currently working on the Story Telling and Friendship Feast themes

- Read books related to Thanksgiving
- Brainstorm things that they are thankful for
- Made turkey hat
- Made placemat
- Took turn telling a fiction story and acted out the story
- Learned about characters, setting, plots, solution to a story
- Identified parts of a story
- Identified long vowel Aa sound and words with long Aa sound
- Worked on word families: -ot, op, ip, ig

## *Math*

The students continue to work on the unit- Solving Story Problem. This week the students worked on the following math activities:

- Solved a problems in which the total and one part are unknown
- Explored relationship among combinations of numbers up to 10
- Found as many 2-addend combinations of a number as possible.
- Connected written numbers and standard notation to the quantities and actions they represent
- Used numbers and standard notation to record

## *Afternoon-Program*

In the afternoon, the students have been working on the following activities:

- Read Thanksgiving Stories and made their own turkey
- Wrote and made a book about Friendship
- Worked on word families and wrote sentences

## *Science*

The students worked on the Air & Weather unit. The students have been working on several activities:

- Recorded their work in their science journal

- Identify the temperature in the classroom and recorded on a paper thermometer
