

<p>Title:</p> <p>22+ Age Maximum Update</p>	<p>Date: January 30, 2019</p>
<p>Presentation Overview/Action Proposed:</p>	<p>This is a request that temporary authority be conferred upon the superintendent to grant waivers to the maximum age policy, permitting students' requests through a review process to remain enrolled in their current school through June 30th, or August 31st, 2019 (if participating in the summer session).</p> <p>Students wishing to continue at their school beyond age 22 must request a waiver through said review process to be facilitated by designated central office staff and the school leadership team.</p> <p>A new policy recommendation for the maximum age of enrollment will be presented to the School Committee by July 2019.</p>
<p>Educational and Racial Equity Implications:</p>	<p>The waiver extension proposal expands opportunities for some of the district's highest needs students by extending equal opportunities to access a waiver for students over age 22 across the district; increasing the likelihood that they will earn a diploma; and creating an opportunity to actively contact eligible students to ensure that they understand their options. The impacted students will largely be students of color, and include significant numbers of English learners and individuals with special needs.</p>
