# School Year 22-23 COVID-19 Health and Safety

- **Testing**
  - Distribute take home tests weekly
  - Symptomatic testing
- **Vaccine Clinics**
  - Clinics at schools and school events
  - Vaccine education
- **Masking**
  - Masks are optional, but recommended
  - Masks will be required in certain situations
- **Air Quality and Ventilation**
  - Air purifiers
  - Air quality sensors
- **Positive Case Notifications to Families**
  - Positive In-School Symptomatic Communication
  - Cluster Communication
- **Isolation**
  - Masking
  - Isolation space

# Highlights from the BTU Health and Safety MOA

- Staff supervising students who have tested positive while in school will have access to appropriate PPE, including KN95 masks
- Mask and test kits will be provided for staff
- Nurses will have properly fitting N95 masks
- BPS can contract with external agencies for nursing services on a temporary basis and a good faith effort has been made to fill vacancies
- COVID-19 coordinator stipend position, nurses have first right of refusal
- Nurses will perform in school symptomatic testing
- COVID-19 Emergency Paid Sick Leave, 10 additional days for COVID related illness
