## Interpreting Spring 2017 MCAS Results

- Next-Generation MCAS assessments set standards for Meeting Expectations that are more rigorous than the legacy MCAS assessments.
- Massachusetts educators set these standards, and raised them in order to make sure our students will be college- and career- ready.
- Given the fact that Spring 2017 was the first year of a new assessment, 2017 will serve as a baseline year. We expect scores to change over time.
- Difference in results from prior years does NOT mean that students learned more/less; Next-Generation MCAS measures in a different way.
- $60 \%$ of BPS students in grades 3-8 tested online/computer based tests.
- MA DESE controlled for differences based on testing mode in their calculations of scaled scores and student growth.
