REQUIREMENTS FOR QUALIFYING FOR INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP

1. A letter of application
2. A district application fee
3. A statement that participating schools will adhere to the rules and regulations of MIAA
4. An enrollment report
5. A copy of the vote taken by the School Committee authorizing the MIAA to manage interscholastic athletics for the schools.
6. A copy of the brochure describing the programs of study of the schools.
