SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

The Committee discussed details of Dr. Carol R. Johnson's contract in light of her recent announcement that she will step down as superintendent during the summer. Members offered support for Chairman O'Neill to enter into discussions with Chief Financial Officer John McDonough for the position of Interim Superintendent and agreed that a salary of approximately \$250,000 would be appropriate if hired. Mr. O'Neill suggested that, consistent with past practice, the Committee formalize the hiring of the Interim Superintendent with a letter of agreement. Members discussed the importance of setting clear priorities for the Interim Superintendent and the need to keep the district moving forward until a permanent district leader is selected.

ADJOURN

At approximately 3 p.m., the School Committee voted by unanimous consent to adjourn the executive session. The Committee did not return to public session.
