From the Nurse' Office:

- It is the season of colds, flu and other viruses are starting. Headache, sore throat, cough, vomiting, diarrhea, and aches are some of the symptoms. A child who has any of these symptoms and has a **fever (100.4)** should **not** come to school. Your child can't learn well when he/she is ill.
- Please keep your child home until your child is feeling better and **is fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medicine such as Tylenol or Advil** . Please call the school so they know the reason your child is absent. If your child is not improving, please call your child's medical provider.
- Medications should be delivered to the school in a pharmacy or manufacturer-labeled container by a parent/guardian/adult. Please ask your pharmacy to provide separate bottles for school and home. A (30) thirty-day supply of the medication should be delivered to the school. All Forms must accompany these medications-please ask the nurse for the forms. These forms are to be updated **yearly**. This is for oral medicines, epi pens, asthma inhalers etc. Doctors can fax the authorization to dispense medicine directly to the nurse at (617)635-8353 or 7949.

- Updated physicals and immunizations can be sent in anytime.
