- Since 2007 the 4 -year graduation rate has steadily increased, from $57.9 \%$ to $66.7 \%$ in 2014 , the highest rate ever, despite more demanding Competency Determination ${ }^{1}$ (CD) standards required by the state for graduation. Compared to 2013, the four-year rate increased 0.8 percentage points
- Importantly, the percentage of students who did not graduate in four years but who remained in school also increased (to $18.5 \%$ ), equaling the high mark of the 2007 cohort.
- Additionally, the 4 -year cohort dropout rate is the lowest of the nine cohorts, at $12.6 \%$, or 2.1 points lower than the 2013 cohort.
- These numbers predict a higher 5-year graduation rate for the 2014 cohort.
* The 4-year graduation cohort consists of students who were $1^{\text {st }}$ time $9^{\text {th }}$ graders four years prior to the year of graduation; it also includes students who transferred into BPS and excludes students who transferred out of BPS and deaths during the four-year period. ${ }^{1}$ In order to graduate, students must meet all local requirements, and earn a Competency Determination (CD). Students in the class of 2010 and beyond earn a CD by scoring a minimum of 240 (Proficient or Advanced) on the grade 10 MCAS tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics or by scoring a minimum of 220 (Needs Improvement) in these tests and completing an Educational Proficiency Plan (EPP). Students must also score a minimum of 220 (Needs Improvement) on a high school Science \& Technology/Engineering MCAS test. For students in the classes of 2009 and prior, earning a CD meant scoring a 220 (Needs Improvement) or higher on the grade 10 MCAS ELA and Math tests only (Science CD was not required).

## 4-Year Graduation Rate By Race/Ethnicity



- Compared to the previous cohort, the 4-year graduation rate for students in two of the four major racial/ethnic groups increased. The increase for Asian students was 3.9 percentage points and Black students saw a 2.2-point gain in their graduation rate. The 4-year graduation rate for White students dropped 2.7 percentage points to $72.3 \%$, and the rate for Hispanic students remained the same as that of previous cohort (59.8\%).
- Data from the past nine cohorts show that Asian students have the highest 4-year graduation rate, while Hispanic students have the lowest.
- Four-year graduation rates have fluctuated for all racial/ethnic groups over the past nine cohorts, but a steady improvement can be seen since 2006 for Black and Hispanic students especially, with a 10.1-point gain for Black students and a 9.2-point gain for Hispanic students.

## 4-Year Graduation Rate By Other Student Group



- Compared to the 2013 cohort, all student groups except students with disabilities in the 2014 cohort saw noticeable increases in their 4-year graduation rates. Specifically, the rate was up 1.3 points for English language learners (ELLs); 1point for male students; 0.6 percentage points for low-income students; and 0.5 points for female students; Students with Disabilities (SWD) experienced a 3.7point decrease in their graduation rate.
- Compared to the 2006 cohort, students in all groups have seen increases in their graduation rates (5 points or more). Male students experienced the most notable gains(8.1 points).

- In order to meet the 2015 federally approved graduation rate target, schools must either (1) achieve an 85\% 4year graduation rate for the 2014 cohort, or (2) achieve a $90 \% 5$-year graduation rate for the 2013 cohort. Based on the 4 -year rate, eight schools have met the $85 \%$ target.
